



SCHOOL CLOSURE UPDATE FROM LANCASTER COUNTY ACADEMY

March 17, 2020

On Friday, March 13, we communicated Governor Wolf's announcement of the state-wide closure of Pennsylvania schools for 10 business days.

Yesterday, we were notified all HACC campuses will be closed to students and are tentatively scheduled to re-open on April 6. We are honoring the directive of HACC's President to remain closed and limit public contact. The April date is tentative and subject to change.
