



SCHOOL CLOSURE UPDATE FROM LANCASTER COUNTY ACADEMY

March 24, 2020

Last week, we communicated HACC's President's announcement to close all campuses until April 6. Yesterday, Governor Wolf and the Pennsylvania Department of Education extended the state-wide closure of schools for the same time period.

Lancaster County Academy (LCA) is now scheduled to re-open to students on April 9, while staff members are able to return on April 7. These dates are considered tentative and are subject to change.
